Date: October 27-28-th. 2017

Introduction:

Many regions in Europa suffer the exploitation of energy sources from their area. Energy-companies or governments do not-, or hardly, compensate the exploitation which has been going on for many years. Since the start and also during the exploitation phase also the democratic processes showed a lack of influence from the population.

The [European Free Alliance \(EFA\)](#), as European Political party (EUPP) representing through its members a large number of European regions, has taken the initiative for an independent research on most issues dealing with the development and implementation of sustainable energy. This initiative stimulates the co-operations amongst the regions and will strengthen their plans for the energy-transition as to be expected between the years 2020 and 2050.

The SEC2017 [Sustainable Energy Conference 201] is part of an EFA program which takes place in the city of Leeuwarden this year. Experts from several countries and regions have been invited and participate in an interactive program. Most issues concerning the expected energy-transition will be discussed in the different sessions be it technical, economic or political. This last issue is one of the challenges for the people in the different regions. How can they gain and keep influence in the decision processes. How can they interact with the stakeholders for the benefit of their region[s]. There will be major challenges, that's for sure!

This SEC2017 event fits well in the future energy plans for Fryslân as recently it was the “province” who took the initiative to investigate the ideas and suggestions of people and authorities for a possible future Frisian Energy Strategy. The outcome to be presented by October 10th.

For all those who are interested in the subject and gain more knowledge and insights this is a unique opportunity to share ideas in interactive sessions. Specifically for the Frisian area (as a “case”) we will show how knowledge can be shared and used for the benefit of the regional economy.
